

## GUIDELINES ON SUSPENSION OF CLASSES (DISTANCE LEARNING and FACE TO FACE ACTIVITIES) AND SCHOOL OPERATIONS IN TIMES OF SEVERE WEATHER CONDITIONS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2023-2024

*(Amended based on DepEd Order 37 Series of 2022)*

In compliance with the guidelines released by DepEd on the cancellation or suspension of classes and work in schools in the event of disaster and other natural calamities, LSCA is hereby amending the school guidelines as follows:

1. **Based on the 5AM PAGASA Bulletin**, when a Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal (TCWS) is raised in Rizal, **ALL classes** (online and onsite) in **ALL levels** and office operations are suspended/cancelled.
2. **Based on the 5AM PAGASA Bulletin**, when an Orange or a Red Rainfall Warning is raised in Rizal, **ALL classes** (online and onsite) in **ALL levels** and office operations are suspended/cancelled.
3. In cases of inclement weather and 1) **no** TCWS is raised; 2) a **Yellow** Rainfall Warning is raised; 3) **no** Rainfall Warning is raised by PAGASA, the school will follow the declaration of the local government of Antipolo. The following guidelines will be followed:

### 3.1 Declaration: NO CLASSES ALL LEVELS

- All classes (online and onsite) in **ALL levels** shall be automatically cancelled or suspended.
- School operations are suspended.

### 2.2 Declaration: NO CLASSES BASIC EDUCATION UNIT

- All classes (online and onsite) in **ALL levels** shall be automatically cancelled or suspended.
- School operations are suspended.

### 2.3 Declaration: NO CLASSES GRADE SCHOOL

- All classes (online and onsite) in **Preschool** and **Grade School** shall be automatically cancelled or suspended.
- Classes in Junior High School and Senior High School will continue.
- Regular office operations.

4. In cases of inclement weather and no storm signal warning is raised by PAGASA and no announcement is made by the local government of Antipolo, the school will evaluate the situation and will post an official announcement if classes will be suspended. **No announcement from the school means classes will push through.**
5. Consideration will be given to students who cannot attend synchronous or face to face classes and submit asynchronous tasks during inclement weather conditions. Affected students/parents need to communicate right away with the Office of the Vice Principal of their respective cluster for such cases.
6. The school will release official announcements on the suspension of learning activities and/or school operations through the official social media sites and Learning Management System.
